# Academic jobs, 1

## University positions

1. To become a maître de conférences, a preliminary step is **qualification**.

This begins with a registration, to be performed on the Galaxie/**Odysée website**

All scientific and administrative documents need be uploaded before :

- **December 6th, 2024** at 4pm if **PhD defense before November 23rd**
- **Deadline extended** until **January 17th, 2025** at 4pm if **PhD defense between November 23rd, 2024 and January 10th**.

Qualification results will be published on March 24th, 2025. [Calendrier\\_qualification\\_CAND\\_2025.pdf\(enseignementsup-recherche.gouv.fr\)](#)

Being qualified by either section 25 or 26 makes you eligible to all positions in maths.

2. Openings in universities are usually published in march, deadlines for applications are in april.

Universities shortlist interviews (april-may), and then produce an ordered list (may). Candidates then confirm whether they take the position (june). See [Opération Postes](#).
